Biography

Born on April 3, 1952, in Fort Lauderdale, FL, Ann Barbara Wrobleski received a bachelor's degree from Stephens College in 1972. Prior to joining the government Ms. Wrobleski was assistant press secretary to Senator Edward Gurney of Florida from 1973-1974, and a traveling press secretary for the Senate campaign of Jack Eckerd in 1974. From 1975-1978 she served as a research assistant for the House Republican Research Committee, and as the press secretary for Congressman Lou Frey. Wrobleski worked as deputy press secretary and director of scheduling for Senator Richard Stone of Florida from 1979-1980.

In 1981 Wrobleski joined the Reagan White House as the Director of Projects in the Office of the First Lady. Although a small portion of her time in this role dealt with invitations, the majority of her duties focused on two of Mrs. Reagan's biggest projects – foster grandparents and youth drug abuse. Ms. Wrobleski managed these projects by researching and recommending to Mrs. Reagan which programs and events the First Lady would accept, performing pre-advance for trips, and briefing Mrs. Reagan on confirmed projects.

In early 1985 Ms. Wrobleski left the White House to join the State Department where she served as the Deputy Assistant Secretary for International Narcotics Matters. In 1986 she received a promotion as the Assistant Secretary for International Narcotics Matters. In 1987 President Reagan designated Ms. Wrobleski as Representative of the United States of America on the Commission on Narcotic Drugs of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations.

Following her work for the government Ann Wrobleski spent nine years in government consulting, as chief executive officer of Halliday, Inc., and in executive roles at The Jefferson Group. She then joined American Forest & Paper Association as its Vice President, International. Ms. Wrobleski is currently Vice President of Global Government Relations for International Paper.

Scope and Content

The material is related to the Grandparent Foster Program, and teenage drug and alcohol abuse. Files contain responses to invitations for Mrs. Reagan to visit sites, attend conferences, meetings, banquets, and to give speeches to various organizations. Also included are messages to benefits, and thank you messages from Mrs. Reagan to people who filled out questionnaires for "To Love

a Child". The Library has not designated any separate series, but considers the entire collection a "chron file." It is arranged chronologically by folder title.
