~~The Coalition for the Strategic Defense Initiative~~ is holding a grassroots briefing on President Reagan's Strategic Defense Initiative on Thursday, November 7, 1985, at the Birmingham, Alabama Civic Center. We would be honored for President Reagan to address the more than three thousand attendees. Represented at the conference will be students, college professors, religious leaders, veterans, business leaders, public officials, and other members of the Coalition.

This informal SDI coalition has been meeting for over two years. This event will be the most important grassroots activity we have undertaken to date. We expect participants from all fifty states. The day-long briefing will include speakers from the Department of Defense, the SDI Organization, prominent scientists such as Dr. Robert Jastrow, Members of Congress, and other SDI proponents.


As you know, Americans overwhelmingly support SDI when they understand the President's program. On November 7 we intend to greatly advance that educational effort. The President's trip to Birmingham would increase public awareness of one of the most important issues facing the world today.

Since the President's attendance is so crucial to this event, the briefing could be rescheduled for November 4, 6, or 8, 1985.
