The Coalition for the Strategic Defense Initiative is holding a grassroots briefing on President Reagan's Strategic Defense Initiative on Thursday, November 7, 1985, at the Birmingham, Alabama Civic Center. We would be honored for President Reagan to address the more than three thousand attendees. Represented at the conference will be students, college professors, religious leaders, veterans, business leaders, public officials, and other members of the Coalition.

This informal SDI coalition has been meeting for over two years. This event will be the most important grassroots activity we have undertaken to date. We expect participants from all fifty states.
